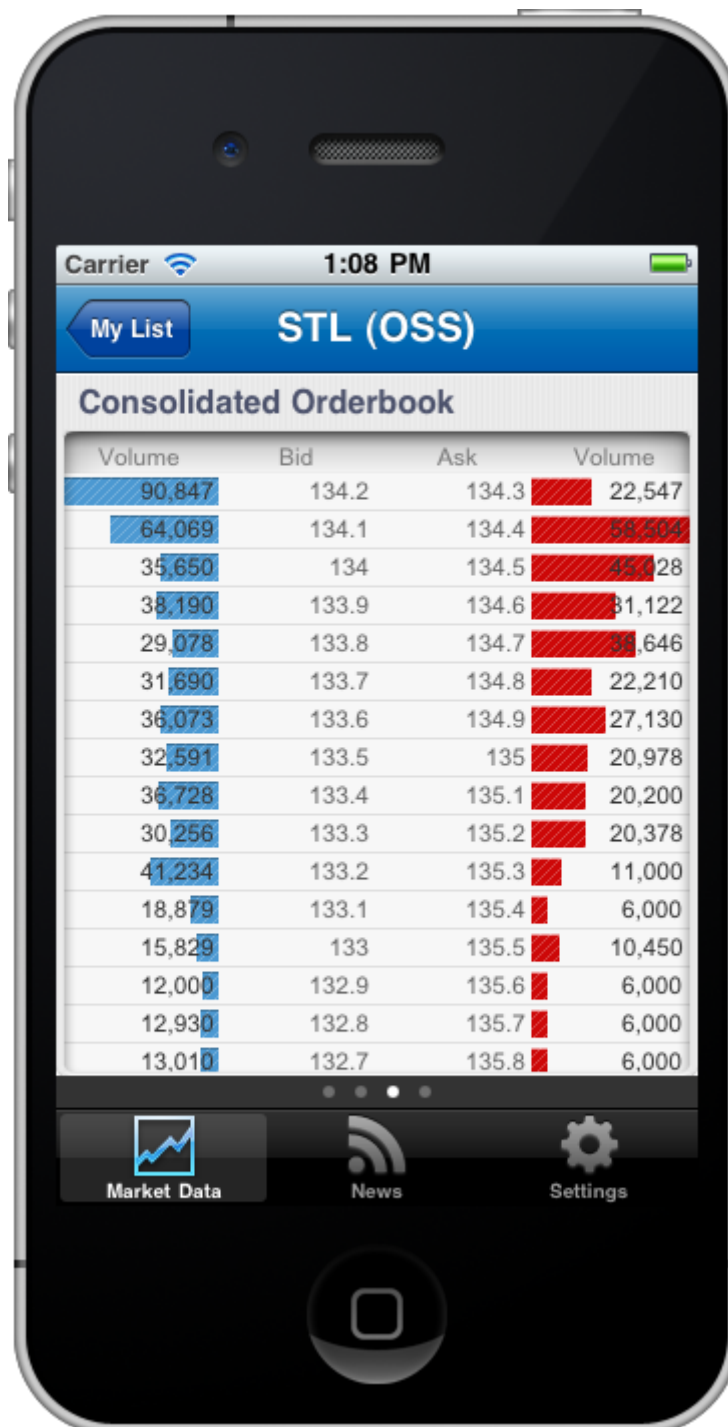

1. About mTrader

Get streaming data from more than 50 exchanges in realtime, specialist data and news with mTrader

Infront's mTrader is a convenient way to follow the markets in realtime anywhere you are with your iPhone. Infront provides realtime market data from more than 50 exchanges and several news agencies. With mTrader you get instant access to the same markets as your The Online Trader subscription.

Benefits

- Access to the markets anywhere
- Realtime streaming quotes
- Create your own lists of instruments
- Combine data from different markets

Available sources

mTrader contains information from several sources; Exchanges and News agencies in realtime. You will have access to the same realtime sources as in you're "The Online Trader" subscription. See www.goinfront.com for more information.

Subscription fee

As a customer of Infront, you can subscribe to mTrader for a small additional fee each month. You do not have to pay extra exchange fees to use mTrader, since the solution use the same login server and you can only be logged in one place at a time. This makes the service especially cost efficient.

2. Installation

- Go to App Store on your iPhone.
- Search for "mTrader".
- Install the application by clicking "Free" and then "Install app".
- Installation starts as soon as you type in your password for the App Store.
- When installation is complete, launch mTrader by clicking icon.

3. Login

- A. Click on the mTrader icon on you iPhone to start the program
- B. Enter your user name and password (same as for the terminal)
- C. Click "Done" and go back to the "My List" tab.

If you get the message "Login Failed" go back to step B and be sure to enter the correct username and password. If you still get the message "Login Failed", you might not have access to the mTrader service. For help on how to add additional services, see www.theonlinetrader.com/support/

After the first successful login, your iPhone will remember your username and password.

3.1. Connection options

mTrader can connect via WiFi or 3G. The connection is controlled by the “Settings” in the main menu of your iPhone.

4. Main menu

The main menu includes the following:

- My List
 - Key Figures
 - Chart
 - Trades
 - Orderbook
 - News
- News
- Settings

4.1. My List

Your selected Symbols will be displayed here.

To edit your list you can either upload a list from the terminal (see separate section) or go to the “+” button in the top right corner of your screen.

Symbols can be browsed inside the list using your finger to swipe up or down the screen.

From the “My List” screen you can access more detailed view of the Symbols by tapping the Symbol you want to see.

Delete Symbols in your list by tapping “Edit”, “-” beside the Symbol you want to delete and then “Delete”. You can also swipe directly on the symbol when in My list view. When in the edit view it is also possible to move symbols up and down by pressing down on the right hand side and move instruments up or down the list.

4.1.1. Key Figures

4.1.1.1. Symbol information

Symbol displays: Bid, Ask, Last, change +/-, change +/-%, Currency, High, Low, Open, Volume, Time.

4.1.1.2. Chart display

Chart displays intraday, by tilting view to horizontal it is possible to view month and year charts as well.

4.1.1.3. News

The symbol specific news list will show news listed for the selected instrument intraday.

You can read the whole news article by tapping the news header. To update the news list, press down and swipe down.

4.1.1.4. Consolidated Orderbook

Displays levels in the orderbook restricted by your level of access to the orderbook in your subscription. The orderbook also supports consolidation, limited according to market data access.

4.2. News

The news tab displays the last 50 news articles from your news feeds.

Scroll through the list of news articles by swiping your finger up or down the screen.

To see the whole new article, tap the news heading you want to read.

If you want to see articles from only one news provider, tap “Feeds” in the top left corner of your screen, and select the news provider you want to see.

New articles are automatically added at the top of the screen as they are added. You can also refresh the list manually by pressing the list and swipe down.

4.3. Settings

The settings screen is where you input your user details. (The same user info as you use in Infront.)

5. Upload watch-list from The Infront terminal

With a subscription to mTrader you can define a list of Symbols in The Infront terminal and upload it to mTrader with a click of a button.

From Infront, open a Composite Window, define your Symbol list dragging symbols from Market windows or typing the symbol named in the search box. Select “Upload to mTrader” action from the toolbar in the Composite Window. When you start mTrader your new watch list will be displayed in “My List”.

6. Trading

User with access to trading in the application will have access to three new main menu items:

- Orders
- Trades
- Portfolio

When accessing one of these tabs the user will be prompted to log in with the Trading Gateway user name and password provided by your broker.

In the Orders menu users can view current orders and modify or delete a single order. Trades allow the user to view today's trades. Portfolio will list the current positions in the portfolio.

It is possible to place an order from virtually anywhere in the application where a single symbol is present; simply press "New Order" in the top right corner.

To log out of the Trading window the user can simply press the home button on the iPhone.
